



## **XIXth World Council – Rome 2015 Resolutions and recommendations – Fees For 2015-2018**

### **Resolutions**

#### **1 – To help development in Catholic networks**

The World Council decides that ICCG, to its extent and its specific nature, helps associations that want to develop Guiding in Catholic networks (parishes, schools...) at a world, as well as a regional and national level.

#### **2 – Spiritual training of guiders**

The World Council decides to organise, in the next triennium, a world seminar on the spiritual training of guiders (for chaplains, training commissioners, programme commissioners, members of spiritual teams) concerning an element of the Guiding method such as life in nature, team life, pledge, law, etc.

#### **3 – Support for chaplains, priests, religious or laity from spiritual teams**

The World Council asks to create a tool showing the pedagogical approach of ICCG of faith education and/or to create a training period at a world or/and regional level that will help chaplains, priests, religious or laity of spiritual teams in their support mission amongst associations.

#### **4 – Guide associations and the Church**

The World Council asks of the world committee and regional teams to help associations who wish, whether open or Catholic, in their relations with the particular Church (national).

#### **5 – ICCG, the regional Church and the Holy See**

The World Council asks of regional teams to make every effort to open or continue relations at group level with Episcopal Conferences' in their regions.

Likewise, it asks the World Committee to ensure that it continues working with the Youth and Women's section of the Pontifical Council for the Laity.

#### **6 – ICCS and ICCG**

The World Council asks of the World Committee to continue the collaboration at world level with ICCS, for instance on the occasion of common celebrations for the centenary of Catholic scouts and guides. It encourages regional teams, depending on their situation, to create, re-create or maintain relations with ICCS in their region.

#### **7 – With WAGGGS**

The World Council asks for further efforts of the regional teams and the world committee be present, in agreement with WAGGGS, at various international events organised by WAGGGS, at a world and regional level, and to contribute their experience in the education of the spiritual dimension.

#### **8 – Asia-Pacific Region**

The World Council decides to continue the work undertaken for the creation of the Asia-Pacific region. It asks every region and every association to support this work with the relations they have with associations in this region.

## **9 – Peace-making**

The World Council asks of the World Committee and regional teams to encourage associations into peace making through interreligious and ecumenical dialogue. Considering the reality of open associations, where there are Catholics, it can be important to consider interreligious dialogue especially with the perspective of fostering mutual knowledge and peace as Pope Francis asks us.

## **10 - Cost of ICCG events**

The World Council asks the World Committee and regional teams to pay good attention on the cost of ICCG world and regional events in order to encourage participation of a wide range of countries and participants to ICCG events.

## **11- Financial report**

Noting: the need to better comply with Art. 21, Statute and Art. 20 and 21, bye-laws

Recalling: a similar resolution by 2009 World Council

Requests: the World Committee to submit all financial documents to member associations, at the latest, two weeks prior to Council meeting;

Furthermore, identifying the financial documents to be submitted:

- The Financial Report for the past triennium, including both “profit and loss” and “assets and liabilities” sheets; both to be compared with previous budget
- The provisional budget for the next triennium

## **Recommendations**

### **Relationship of Men/Women**

The World Council recommends regional teams and member associations to complete the document on educating the alliance of man-woman in order to use it for meetings in the next triennium.

## **SUBSCRIPTION RATE**

The World Council decides a membership fee system that takes into account the standard of living of the member countries.

The membership fee system is:

- **For associations with more than 1800 members.**

WEST EUROPE + NORTH AMERICA + ASIA-PACIFIC	0,219 € per member
EAST and CENTRAL EUROPE	0,106 € per member
AFRICA + REST OF THE H.O. REGION + MIDDLE EAST	0,053 € per member

- **For associations with less than 1800 members**

A minimum charge of 100 € is applied.
